

## Policy:

Bismarck State College prohibits the use of tobacco and cigarettes on campus property and sponsored off-campus events at all times. Tobacco use includes all tobacco-derived products, including, but not limited to: cigarettes, cigars, pipes, cigars, chewing tobacco, snuff, smokeless pouches, and other forms of loose tobacco. This prohibition includes indoors, outdoors, and college/state vehicles. This policy applies to all employees, students, and visitors. This policy will be reflected in all agreements/contracts for use of BSC grounds and property. This poli-

mitted under this exception must be limited to the guidelines as stated in the Residence Life Handbook
